PERFECTLY PREPARED TO HANDLE THE "FULLNESS" OF THE COVENANT BLESSINGS

Words of Prophecy:

* *Faith "begins" where My Word/Will is "revealed" to one's heart - and "miracles" [divine interventions] are the spontaneous fruit of believing in AND acting upon [in the power and unction of the Holy Spirit] the revelation of My heart and Will abiding [dwelling] in one's heart.*

"miracle" - the intervention of God's supernatural power into the natural scheme of things.

...."ALL things are possible to him who believes".... Mark 9:23 NASB

"definitive" - providing a solution or final answer; satisfying all criteria;

It is of the utmost importance for every child of God to come to the full realization that the exercising of our faith [*absolute trust in the Father and His Word*] BEGINS [*and, for that matter, ends {is fulfilled}*] with a revelation of the Father's Will/Word.
