A BREAKTHROUGH UNPARALLELED IN THE HISTORY OF THE CHURCH

Words of prophecy:

* "Distraction" has been a widespread tactic against My remnant Church in this season. Ultimately, though, it has only served to alert My faithful ones to the fact that they need to simply pursue diligence in this hour - a diligence that will lead to great things, and a level of "breakthrough" unparalleled in the history of the Church.

...."Now as they were traveling along, He entered a village; and a woman named Martha welcomed Him into her home.
