CALLING THINGS THAT BE NOT AS THOUGH THEY ALREADY ARE

Words of prophecy:

* I have called each and every one of My precious children to continually call [speak, proclaim] those things that do not yet exist in the "natural realm" [their physical circumstances] as if they already did [exist in the physical realm]! For, in reality, everything that I have called them to stand in faith for ALREADY does exist in Heaven [in My Heart] and, thus, it is "their" faith [love and obedience] alone that will cause it to manifest in the earthly realm - according to My highest purpose in any given moment.

...."Your Will be done on earth as it is [ALREADY] done [has been established] in Heaven [in Your Heart] Matthew 6:10 The Amplified Translation

...."Now faith is the assurance [the confirmation, the title deed] of the things [we] hope for, being the proof of things [we] do not see and the conviction of their reality [faith perceiving as real fact what is not revealed to the senses]".... Hebrews 11:1 The Amplified Translation

...."[Earnestly] remember the former things, [which I did] of old; for I am God, and there is no one else; I am God, and there is none like Me, Declaring the end and the result from the beginning, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all My pleasure and purpose".... ...."For our light, momentary affliction [this slight distress of the passing

hour] is ever more and more abundantly preparing and producing and achieving for us an everlasting weight of glory [beyond all measure, excessively surpassing all comparisons and all calculations, a vast and transcendent glory and blessedness never to cease!], Since we consider and look not to the things that are seen but to the things that are unseen; for the things that are visible are temporal [brief and fleeting], but the things that are invisible are deathless and everlasting".... 2 Corinthians 4:17-18 The Amplified Translation

True "confession" [profession, proclamation] is, in reality, the entire expression of one's life [both words and actions].

Prayer of Proclamation:

Father, we thank You and praise You that you have raised us up a people of faith - a Kingdom-people who continually call [speak] things [into existence] that be not [yet] in the physical realm as though they already are [which they already are in Heaven]. We rejoice and praise You with all of our hearts for this life of faith You have empowered us to live out in this earth - for it is truly Glorious! We declare all of these things DONE - and we give You ALL honour, praise and Glory in Jesus' Name. Amen.

...."For this reason it is by faith, in order that it may be in accordance with grace, so that the promise will be guaranteed to all the descendants, not only to those who are of the Law, but also to those who are of the faith of Abraham, who is the father of us all, [as it is written, "a father of many nations have I made you"] in the presence of Him whom he believed, even God, who gives life to the dead and calls into being that which does not exist. In hope against hope he believed, so that he might become a father of many nations according to that which had been spoken, "so shall your descendants be."
