TRANSITION INTO THE "FULLNESS" OF THE FATHER'S HIGHEST PURPOSE IS ALWAYS A BIT "DISORIENTING"

Words of prophecy:

* *I know everything each and every one of My faithful ones have gone through and it is certain that, I, according to His Word, will most certainly restore ALL that the Enemy has stolen [time, finances, relationships etc.] to them in ways that are exceeding abundantly beyond all they can even imagine.*

*...."rejoice, O sons/daughters of Zion, and be glad in the LORD your God; For He has given you the early rain for [your] vindication. And He has poured down for you the rain, The early and latter rain as before. The threshing floors will be full of grain, and the vats will overflow with the new wine and oil. **Then I will make up to you for the years that the swarming locust has eaten,..... You will have plenty to eat and be satisfied and praise the name of the LORD your God, Who has dealt wondrously with you".... Joel 2:23-26 NASB***

"It [the vision] hastens toward the goal and it will not fail. Though it tarries, wait for it; For it will certainly come, it will not delay. Behold, as for the proud one, his soul is not right within him; But the righteous will live by his faith".... Habakkuk 2:3-4 NASB

Transition into the "fullness" of the Father's highest Purpose is ALWAYS a bit "disorienting" - regardless of how much preparation one has experienced

In these days, it should be the deepest desire of one's heart to continue to hold fast to a steadfast faith *[trust]* and obedience - because it is certain that the remnant Church is very, very close to the biggest breakthrough and time of divine restoration in the entire history of the Church age!
