GRACE "ABOUNDING"

Words of prophecy:

* The accessing of My Grace is an "act of love" towards Me. Therefore the continual accessing of My Grace [through the continual exercising of an absolute faith and trust] is the perfect fruit of the heart that "abides" in Love [towards both Me, and all who cross their path].

...."Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God".... Romans 5:1-2 KJV

...."Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself unless it abides in the vine, so neither can you unless you abide in Me. I am the vine, you are the branches; he who abides in Me and I in him, he bears much fruit, for apart from Me you can do nothing.
