FREEDOM FROM SHAME, UNWORTHINESS AND CONDEMNATION

Words of Prophecy:

* One of the things that will be "obliterated" in the midst of My people in this hour will be "shame" [unworthiness]. It is one of the main schemes against My daughters - but many will be set free in this hour and, from that place of victory, they will go forth to set many other "sons and daughters" free.

...."Fear not, for you will not be put to shame; And do not feel humiliated, for you will not be disgraced; But you will forget the shame of your youth"....
