To all those who are truly seeking first the Kingdom - those who love God with all of their heart:

JESUS IS COMING TO HIS CHURCH IN THIS HOUR

...."Again, the kingdom of heaven is like unto treasure hid in a field; the which when a man hath found, he hideth, and for joy thereof goeth and selleth all that he hath, and buyeth that field. Again, the kingdom of heaven is like unto a merchant man, seeking goodly pearls: Who, when he had found one pearl of great price, went and sold all that he had, and bought it"....

Matthew 13:44-46 NASB

Jesus [and all that He is] must be our "treasure" - for He truly is the "pearl of great price". The key to all things pertaining to our Kingdom-destiny, in Christ, is for us to be found keeping our eyes "fixed" on Jesus [the Word of God and His "finished work" - Ephesians 2:10] from here on in. The "Divine Requirement" is for us to love the Lord our God with ALL of our heart and the counterfeit of that is the "love of money". Therefore, to the degree that one's heart is not wholly given to the Will/Word of God [godly desire] it is to that degree that they will remain bound [perhaps unknowingly - but they would know if they spent time in the secret place of God's Presence on a daily basis] to a certain degree by the "spirit of mammon" [self-desire] - and this is precisely why there are certain wrong manifestations and attitudes [false doctrines] happening out there in the church at large. The wonderful news is that Jesus is coming TO His Church in this hour and that will most certainly obliterate [through a holy people filled to overflowing with holy fire] all in the midst of His people which is NOT of Him.

...."Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself unless it abides in the vine, so neither [can] you unless you abide in Me. I am the vine, you are the branches; he who abides in Me and I in him, he bears much fruit, for apart from Me you can do nothing. If anyone does not abide in Me, he is thrown away as a branch and dries up; and they gather them, and cast them into the fire and they are burned".... John 15:4-6 NASB

DAYS OF TREMENDOUS REFINING

These are days of tremendous refining [and polishing] in the midst of all those who are truly seeking the fullness of their destiny, in Christ. Be greatly encouraged - for that which is presently in the temporal circumstances of the one who is truly seeking the fullness of God's Will for their life and ministry shall soon be no longer!

IT IS ONLY THE EXERCISING OF FAITH AND LOVE [THROUGH OBEDIENCE] THAT WILL SUPERCEDE [THE FORCE OF] FEAR

It is of the utmost importance in this hour for every last child of God to know [gain a deep revelation of the spiritual reality] that it is ONLY the exercising of faith and Love [which are Kingdom "forces"] that will "supercede" [the force of] fear. Therefore, as one sets themselves to walk in faith, love and obedience the spontaneous fruit will be a constant flow of Grace [divine empowerment] that will keep them in the "high place" [seated at the right hand of the Father, in Christ].

This is how one truly enters into the place of having "both feet" firmly planted in the Kingdom - far above the "world" and its oppressive and darkened [fear-filled] ways. This truly is a time of "miracles" [divine interventions] and great [divine] restoration on every front - and, thus, it is certain that we [as we continue to exercise faith and trust in the Father and His Word] - will not be disappointed in ANY way as God's plan for our life and ministry unfolds perfectly before us.

supercede - to replace in power, authority, effectiveness; to set aside or cause to be set aside as void, useless, or obsolete; supplant;

"perfect obedience" - receiving a revelation of the Father's Will, and then carrying out that Will in the timing [unction] and power of the Holy Spirit - alone [through the continual exercising of an absolute faith working through a perfect love];

REMAIN "READY

"ready" - completely prepared or in fit condition for immediate action or use; duly equipped, completed, adjusted, or arranged, as for an occasion or purpose [in this case, the fullness of Kingdom-position and destiny in Christ]; willing;

As mentioned earlier, presently, all those who are truly seeking God are undergoing a very intense time of refining and polishing - a time of refining and polishing that will bring forth the fruit of an "abiding" [and absolute] faith and trust. The Father has a particular [and very special] plan for each and every one of His precious children in the glorious days just ahead - how exactly that manifests ONLY He knows right now. Therefore, it is of the utmost importance for us, as true sons and daughters, to simply remain "ready" - continually keeping our eyes fixed on the "things that are not seen".

When the Father's plan begins to unfold in an accelerated manner in this hour, one of the very first things that will happen [manifest in and by the power of the Holy Spirit] is that "true spiritual environments" will begin to spring up suddenly throughout the remnant Church in every nation [and that will open wide the final page of Church history - right through to the end of the age]. The spontaneous fruit of this will be that the true unity and one accord [fullness of corporate anointing] in the midst of His people that the Father so desires will come into manifestation - causing a glorious Church to rise up [in GREAT power] in the earth.

Indeed, what He has planned for His faithful and obedient ones between now and the time we leave here is ALMOST incomprehensible. So our task, then, is to simply believe and trust in Him [focusing on the revelation in our hearts] - "knowing" [maintaining a deep revelation of the spiritual reality] that EVERYTHING He has both spoken and promised will SURELY come to pass in ways that are exceeding abundantly beyond all we ever asked or thought.!

IT IS A WORK THAT ONLY HE [THE FATHER] CAN DO

Again, the key now, in all of our lives, is continually positioning ourselves to receive the deep, deep work that the Holy Spirit is doing in each of us - in order that we might enter into that place of an abiding faith, love and trust towards the Father. It is a work that ONLY He can do - as, ultimately, it must be the Father, Himself [by His Spirit - Who is the Spirit of Love], that "seals" us in Himself [in His Love]. This is the final step for one's entrance into the "fullness" of their Kingdom-position and destiny, in Christ, and the fullness of true Kingdom [Covenant]-living that is its spontaneous fruit.
