MEDITATIONS ON THE TRUE CHRISTIAN LIFE

...."This book of the law [the Word of God] shall not depart from [always be in] your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it; for THEN you will make your way prosperous, and THEN you will have success".... Joshua 1:8 NASB

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* Everything that has been made [created] in the material realm was made by God's words and, therefore, everything made responds to His Words. Thus, our entire lives are the result of our response to the Word of God - both in our physical lives in the earth and Eternity. How we see His words, how we treat His words, if we believe His words or do not believe [trust in] His words, receive His words or do not receive His words, if we do [carry out] His Words or refuse to do His words - whatever our response is to the Word of God, that is the sum total [result] of our life.

"Go into all the world and preach the Good News" - those are the words of God. What then happens: if one believes THEN they will be "saved" and if they refuse to believe it they will not be saved but rather condemned. What determined the person's life both now and in Eternity: their response to God's words.
