* Every one of us, as children of God, must come to the place of abiding in "Christian perfection"; for it is only in this place that the Evil One "touches" us not! We must put aside any provision we have made "in the flesh" to "get us through" and, in putting aside this "double-mindedness", we shall surely come to understand God's power (ability) to bring us through the "impossible", and we shall find "all" of our "sufficiency" in God. For it is certain that we have yet to experience the fulness of God's ability, in the Holy Spirit and in Christ, to "quicken" and empower us to walk wholly in the supernatural realm.

Let our remaining time on earth be a time of faithfulness to the "omnipotent" God that we serve, for it is only the "unfaithfulness" of His children that can "limit" Him in carrying our the "mighty works that He has ordained His "spotless and unblemished" Church to carry out. We must strive, in the Lord, to put aside "all" fear, and the ground thereof, that God might have His way with us. For it must be understood that unless we constantly place ourselves in the position of "confrontation" (perfect obedience and therefore perfect intercession) we will "allow" the Evil One to "touch" (influence) us in some way, and thus allow ourselves to be used to "dissuade" others from the narrow path of perfect obedience and from "attaining to" (to succeed in reaching) a revelation of the fulness of God's Divine Requirement.

For if these qualities are yours and are increasing, they render you neither useless nor unfruitful in the true knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. For he who lacks these qualities is blind or short-sighted, having forgotten his purification from his former sins.
