* Holding to unforgiveness in any of its forms [offense, resentment, bitterness] condemns one's own heart and "negates" [quenches] the flow [capability] of faith in their prayers.

"negate" - to deny the existence, evidence or truth of; to nullify or cause to be ineffective;

"quench" - to put out or extinguish; supress;
