["Reflections" Of The Father's Heart]

* I desire My children to be found seeking at "all" times to enter into the place of "abiding" [dwelling constantly] in a "Kingdom-normalcy" - a place wherein they are found continually walking in [and diligently pursuing a continually deeper revelation of] the "fullness" of their Covenant with Me, in Christ.

Truly I say to you, what the "religious church" deems normal and what I deem "normal" *[Christ, all in all]* are two completely different things, altogether!

"**normalcy**" - constituting a standard [in this case, one operating in the"fullness" of the stature of Christ on a regular basis];
