["Reflections" Of The Father's Heart]

* In these days, I am "wresting" the last vestiges of "self" control [*fear and pride*] from the lives of all those who are truly seeking first My Kingdom.

Truly I say to you, these are the days of "final preparation" - a final preparation that will see many enter [*without "spot or wrinkle"*] into the "fullness" of their true Kingdom position and destiny, in Christ.

"wrest" - to twist or turn; pull, jerk, or force by a violent twist; to take away by force [*in this case, the "forces" of the Kingdom: Love, Wisdom etc.*];

"They will be Mine," says the LORD of hosts, "on the day that I prepare [My] own possession, and I will spare them as a man spares his own son who serves him."
