### April 1st

#### A "NEW UNDERSTANDING" THAT EMPOWERS ONE TO SEE THE REALITY OF THE TRUE CHURCH AND THE KINGDOM

#### Words of prophecy:

\* It is now the time wherein I shall call each one of those who truly love Me, out and away from the bondages of "denominationalism". Truly I say to you, only those who are willing to forsake any and every attachment with the world will obey My instructions to separate themselves from those whom they have "fellowshipped" with up until this time. Therefore, stay ready! Stay alert! For there shall be many inquiries - by those whom I will send to you - about the walk of faith and the principles of My Kingdom.

.... "Do not be bound together with unbelievers; for what partnership have righteousness and lawlessness, or what fellowship has light with darkness? Or what harmony has Christ with Belial, or what has a believer in common with an unbeliever? Or what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For we are the temple of the living God; just as God said, 'I will dwell in them and walk among them; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. Therefore, come out from their midst and be separate, says the Lord. 'and do not touch what is unclean; And I will welcome you. And I will be a father to you, ad you shall be sons and daughters to Me', says the Lord Almighty. Therefore, having these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all defilement of flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God".... 2 Corinthians 6:14-7:1 NASB

Many children of God do not have a revelation of the Body of Christ *[the true Church]* and, thus, they still remain bound to a "spirit of denominationalism". Thus, they are still living a "works" orientated life as far as "church" goes. In light

of these things, gaining a "new understanding" is most important - a new understanding that empowers one to see the reality of the true Church and the Kingdom.

In these days, it is extremely important for each and every believer to do exactly what the Holy Spirit is speaking to their heart concerning "positioning". There are many reasons for this being so important, but I believe that by far the most important one is because: if believers are in "fellowship" with any type of setting, group or "fellowship" that is in some way operating under a "spirit of denominationalism" *[and have thus "plateau-ed" at some point far below the fullness of the Father's Will]* THEN that one who is truly seeking first the Kingdom will IN SOME WAY become "indoctrinated" in their thinking - and thus, they too will fall short of the Father's Glorious plan for their life.
