THE CYCLE OF DIVINE PROSPERITY

VISION: I saw a vision of a person standing in a field with a full bag of seed "in their hand" expecting harvest.

The Father spoke to me and said:

* Sowing in perfect obedience [faith and righteousness] ALWAYS "precedes" [a righteous] harvest.

"perfect obedience" - receiving a revelation of the Father's Will, and then carrying out that Will in the timing [unction] and power of the Holy Spirit - alone [through the continual exercising of an absolute faith working through a perfect love];

...."There is one who scatters, and [yet] increases all the more, and there is one who withholds what is justly due, [and yet it results] only in want. The generous man will be prosperous, and he who waters will himself be watered"....

Proverbs 11:24-25 NASB

As pointed out in the vision above of a person standing in a field with a bag full of see "in their hand", there are many children of God who are NOT sowing and yet are, somehow, expecting a supernatural harvest. In the natural, of course, it clearly makes no sense for a farmer to purchase bags of seed, store them in the barn and, then, look out over his fields "believing" that he will reap a harvest come spring.

Seed must be sown in order for it to bear fruit [both in the natural and spiritually speaking] and, as children of God, we must come to realize that "sowing" [on any level of our existence] is a spiritual exercise that gives us the opportunity to exercise an absolute faith and trust in our loving Father while, at the same time, preparing us to reap a harvest that will SURELY cause us to prosper personally - as well as be used greatly by God to advance His Kingdom in the earth, in this most critical and glorious hour.

As one continually casts their "bread" upon the water, and as they continue to sow bountifully [love, truth-revelation, finances etc.] in accordance with the Word of God and the still, small voice of the Holy Spirit, it is certain that they shall reap a great harvest in this season and they shall come to "abide" in the place wherein the "cycle of Divine prosperity" [the supernatural ability to meet the deepest need of those who cross one's path] is evident in their lives.

In this hour, those who have been faithful shall see clearly the necessity of ministering first unto the Father and His Word in prayer and communion [intimate fellowship]. First to receive, then to "appreciate" [in a "spirit of thanksgiving"], and then to "disperse and scatter" fully the superabundant Kingdom-blessings which they in no way themselves could ever contain, or use properly in their own strength [wisdom].

...."Now this [I say,] he who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. Each one [must do] just as he has purposed in his heart, not grudgingly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that always having all sufficiency in everything, you may have an abundance for every good deed.... Now He who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will supply and multiply your seed for sowing and increase the harvest of your righteousness; you will be enriched in everything for all liberality".... 2 Corinthians 9:6-11 NASB
