#### **FAITH OR UNBELIEF**

### UNBELIEF [MISTRUST] IS AN AFFRONT TO THE FATHER

### Words of prophecy:

\* The continual exercising of faith slams the door shut on the Enemy. The wilful maintaining of fear and unbelief - through a mistrust of Me - opens it wide!

...."So we see that they were not able to enter [into His rest {into the Promised Land}], because of their unwillingness to adhere to and trust in and rely on God [unbelief had shut them out]".... [Num. 14:1-35]".... Hebrews 3:19 The Amplified Translation

We must make no mistake about this: "unbelief" [wilful mistrust] is an affront [insult] to the Father. I am not talking about unbelief caused by an ignorance of God's Word - that can easily be remedied by one truly giving the Word of God preeminence in their lives, on a daily basis. I am talking about the unbelief that, if held to in pride and fear, will cause one's heart be become "unpersuadable" where the absolute Truth of God's Word and the spiritual realities of the Kingdom are concerned.

In this state [of stubbornness and "unpersuadableness"], that which one has come to "believe" [which, in actuality, is a belief and trust in the lies of the Enemy] leaves them in confusion and darkness - wide open to the vile tactics and schemes of the Enemy to keep them from entering into their true position in the

Kingdom and the fullness of their precious destiny, in Christ.
