THE IMPORTANCE OF PROPER FOCUS AND RIGHT FELLOWSHIP

Words of prophecy:

* If one "fellowships" with the world then they are going to think as the world thinks and act as the world acts! If one "fellowships" with Me in My Kingdom [in the secret place of My Presence] then they shall think as I think and act as I act!

...."we have the mind of Christ [the Messiah] and do hold the thoughts [feelings and purposes] of His heart".... 1 Corinthians 2:16b The Amplified Translation

The word above from the Father once again points out the importance of proper focus and right*[eous]* fellowship. We truly do become what we "behold" *[and fellowship with]* to the greatest degree. To have the heart of the Father and the Mind of Christ is ours as His true *[faithful]* sons and daughters.
