THE "SPIRIT OF UNBELIEF" IS REMOVED THROUGH A CONTINUAL RESISTANCE TO IT - IN FAITH

Words of prophecy:

* *The "spirit of unbelief" [and the strongholds established within one's heart by that spirit] is removed through a continual resistance - a resistance that includes, as its spontaneous fruit, a continual proclamation that is aligned perfectly with a revelation of My Will [Word]. For it is ONLY a "revelation" of the Truth that will set one free, and it is ONLY as one speaks [proclaims] and "acts upon" a revelation of absolute Truth on a continual basis that they will enter fully into the ABSOLUTE [perfect] liberty that is ALREADY theirs, in Christ.*

...."And ye shall know [gain a revelation of] the truth, and the truth [that revelation of the truth that enters your heart] shall make [and keep] you free".... John 8:32 KJV

...."We are destroying speculations and every lofty thing raised up against the true knowledge of God [and who we ALREADY are, in Christ], and we are taking every thought captive [through proclamation] to the obedience of Christ [a revelation of the Father's Will]".... 2 Corinthians 10:5 NASB

...."Submit therefore to God [in obedience]. Resist the devil [from the position of faith in a revelation of the Father's Word/Will] and he will flee from you".... James 4:7 NASB

Unbelief is a "detractor" [distracter].

"detract" - to draw away or divert; distract *[in this case, from the fullness of one's Kingdom-position and destiny, in Christ]*;

Latin: **"de + tractus"** drawn away, from **"detrahere"** - to pull away;

.... "So we see that they were not able to enter [into His rest - an absolute faith and trust in Him], because of their unwillingness to adhere to and trust in and rely on God [unbelief had shut them out]".... [Num. 14:1-35]".... Hebrews 3:19 The Amplified Translation
