THE KEY TO EFFECTIVE "INTERCESSION" ON ANY LEVEL IS SIMPLY THE EXERCISING OF FAITH AND OBEDIENCE [LOVE] ON OUR PART

Words of prophecy:

* The "feelings" [pressures] that arise while one is bearing another's burden [spiritually in intercessory prayer] are "transitory". So endure [in faith, love and obedience] until the victory [breakthrough] is obtained - knowing [having a revelation of the fact] that your prayers have not been in vain, and that they will bear much fruit for the Kingdom in the glorious days ahead.

"transitory" - existing for a short time only; passing;

...."Bear one another's burdens, and thereby fulfill the law of Christ [which is the law of Love]".... Galatians 6:2 NASB

The key to effective "intercession" on any level is simply the exercising of faith and obedience *[Love]* on our part - regardless of what we are experiencing in the spiritual realm on the behalf of another *[or others]*. It was mostly through intercession that the Father taught me to walk by faith - and, thus, to be free from the "influence" of pressure or the "soulish feelings" that are rooted in fear/pride.

When I started out I was what might be best termed as a "reluctant intercessor". The fear of an "unpleasant feeling" or situation flies right in the face of the call to intercession *[and, of course, faith]* - so through the years there were times where I avoided true intercession. However, I did eventually learn how to walk by faith *[Love]* and, in the process, overcome any fear that I had - fear that

was based on past experiences. So, as one is found faithful to bear the burdens of others through a steadfast Love and obedience in their own lives it is certain that the captives the Father has placed in their path will be set free - and, themselves, brought to the position wherein they, too, might effectively bear the burdens of others in Love.

...."for we walk by faith [in a revelation of God's Word {Will}], not by sight".... 2 Corinthians 5:7 NASB
