DIVINE COMPASSION

Words of prophecy:

* Truly I say to you, in this last hour I am raising up a group who shall minister "absolute truth" in the fullness of conviction [the fullness of My power and love] and, as they go forth with My "compassion" burning in their heart, the yoke-destroying, burden-removing power abiding within them shall be continually released upon all who cross their path. And "miracles" such as the earth has never seen before shall manifest to a continually greater degree, and Satan and his forces shall experience a "terror" that I have reserved for him until this time.

For is it not written,

...."Behold, the tempest of the Lord! Wrath has gone forth, a sweeping [raging] tempest; it will burst on the head of the wicked. The fierce anger of the Lord will not turn back until He has performed and until He has accomplished the intent of His heart; in the latter days you will understand this".... Jeremiah 30:23-24

When dealing with others, everything must be handled in accordance with the precious Holy Spirit - Who is the Spirit of Compassion, Love, wisdom and revelation etc. - abiding within us. There is a "fine line" between one walking in divine Compassion and "sympathy" - a soulish emotion that only serves to put us into agreement *[through fear and unbelief]* with what the Enemy is attempting to do. When a situation that confronts us seems overwhelming it is very important to "step back", at times, in order to regain our "spiritual equilibrium". This will keep our heart "flowing" in divine Compassion and cause the anointed words, prayers and actions that are necessary in any given situation to issue forth - meeting the deepest need of the one before us.

...."So, as those who have been chosen of God, holy and beloved, put on a heart of compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience; bearing with one another, and forgiving each other, whoever has a complaint against anyone; just as the Lord forgave you, so also should you. Beyond all these things put on love, which is the perfect bond of unity".... Colossians 3:12-14 NASB
