"A RECEIVER OF THE THINGS THAT ARE NOT SEEN"

Words of prophecy:

* Through faith, one is empowered [enabled] to perceive a reality [spiritual reality] that is not perceived through the five physical senses. The exercising of faith allows one to become a "receiver" of the things that are "not seen".
