THINGS ARE NOT ALWAYS AS THEY SEEM

Words of prophecy:

* *The byword of this hour: do NOT be "moved" [influenced or moved off course] by what you feel or see or hear or think. Be moved ONLY by that which I have "revealed" to your heart.*
