#### THE FATHER'S HEART IS PURELY SELFLESS LOVE

## Words of prophecy:

\* All trust, as well as trustworthiness, is predicated on one fully forsaking any form of self-agenda in their own life in order to seek the fullness of My highest Will and purpose in any given moment. One either trusts in themselves [their own understanding] for the purpose of fulfilling their own agenda or in Me and in My Word /Will - there is no neutral ground.

...."Do you not know that when you present yourselves to someone as slaves for obedience, you are slaves of the one whom you obey, either of sin resulting in death, or of obedience [faith and love] resulting in righteousness?".... Romans 6:16 NASB

"Trustworthiness" is tied directly to how great our desire is to display [accurately represent] the Father's heart [Love] through our own lives - a godly desire that is both established and fuelled by intimate fellowship with Him in the "inner chamber" on a daily basis. If one is in right fellowship with the Father and His Word [giving that holy and all-powerful Word preeminence in every aspect of their lives] THEN there will be NO room left for unrighteous [selfish] motives to creep into one's heart.

The Father's heart is purely selfless Love - both holy and divine [supernatural] - and, thus, one who is truly found to be a trustworthy friend shows these same characteristics in their relationship with us. To be loved and trusted [and to love and trust] with the purity of the Love of God is a VERY precious thing - not only in our sight but, also in the Father's sight.
