FAITH AND PATIENCE

Words of prophecy:

* *"Patience" becomes a wonderful thing to the hearts of My children when they gain a "revelation" of the spiritual reality that the continual exercising of faith and patience ALWAYS "allows" Me to accomplish My highest purpose - both in them and through them - in any given situation.*

.... "the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control".... Galatians 5:22-23 NASB

.... "And we desire that each one of you show the same diligence so as to realize the full assurance of hope until the end, so that you will not be sluggish, but imitators of those who through faith and patience inherit the promises".... Hebrews 6:11-12 NASB

It is the exercising of faith in a revelation of the Father's Word/Will that orders one's steps on the proper path. The continual exercising of faith and patience *[endurance for the joy set before them]* CANNOT FAIL to inherit the blessing *[promise]* because Love *[faith, obedience]* NEVER fails.

"obedience" - the seeking after and gaining a "revelation" of God's Will and, THEN, carrying it out to fulfilment from beginning to end *[regardless of how long that may take]* in the unction and power of the Holy Spirit *[Who is the Spirit of Love, the Spirit of Christ etc.]*, alone.
